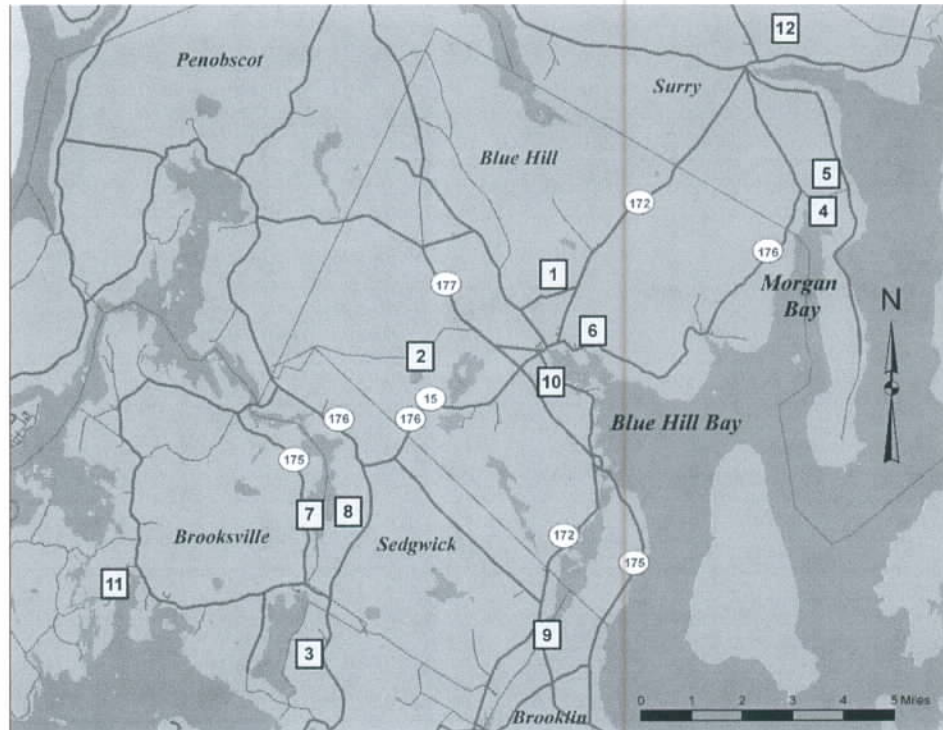

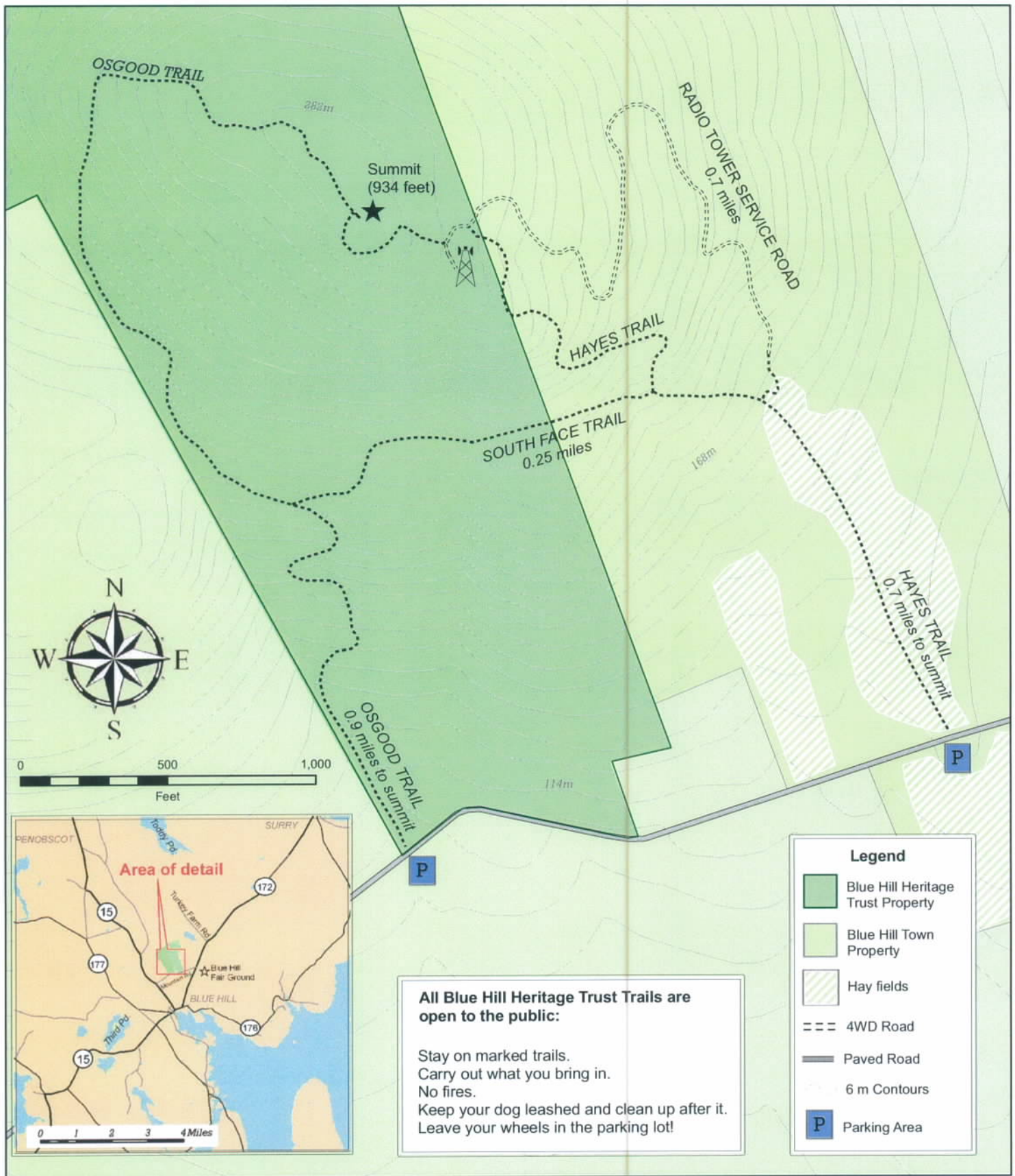

1. Blue Hill Mountain Trails, Blue Hill, Mountain Road. 2 ½ miles of trails on BHHT and Town land.
2. Kingdom Woods Conservation Area, Blue Hill, Kingdom Road. 3 ¼ miles of trails on 800 acres of forest and wetland.
3. Cooper Farm at Caterpillar Hill, Sedgwick, Rt. 15. 2 miles of trails through blueberry fields, and forest.
4. Carter Nature Preserve, Surry, Cross Road. 2/3 mile trail out and back through forest and field and along shoreline.
5. Furth Wildlife Sanctuary and Talalay Nature Sanctuary, Surry, Cross Road. 2 miles of trail through forest.
6. Peter's Cove and Peter's Brook Trail, Blue Hill, East Blue Hill Road. ½ mile trail on private property, leads to waterfall.
7. Bagaduce Canoe Access, Sedgwick, Route 176. 300 ft. footpath leads to river.
8. Snow Cove – 2 mile trail in development.
9. Salt Pond, Sedgwick, Hales Hill Road. 500 ft trail across private field leads to water's edge.
10. South Street to Parker Point Trail, Blue Hill, Parker Point Road. ½ mile forested trail across private property.
11. John B. Mountain, Brooksville, Breezemere Road. 1 mile of trails loops over small mountain with good views.
12. Patten Stream, Surry, Warren Lane. ½ mile loop through forest and along stream.

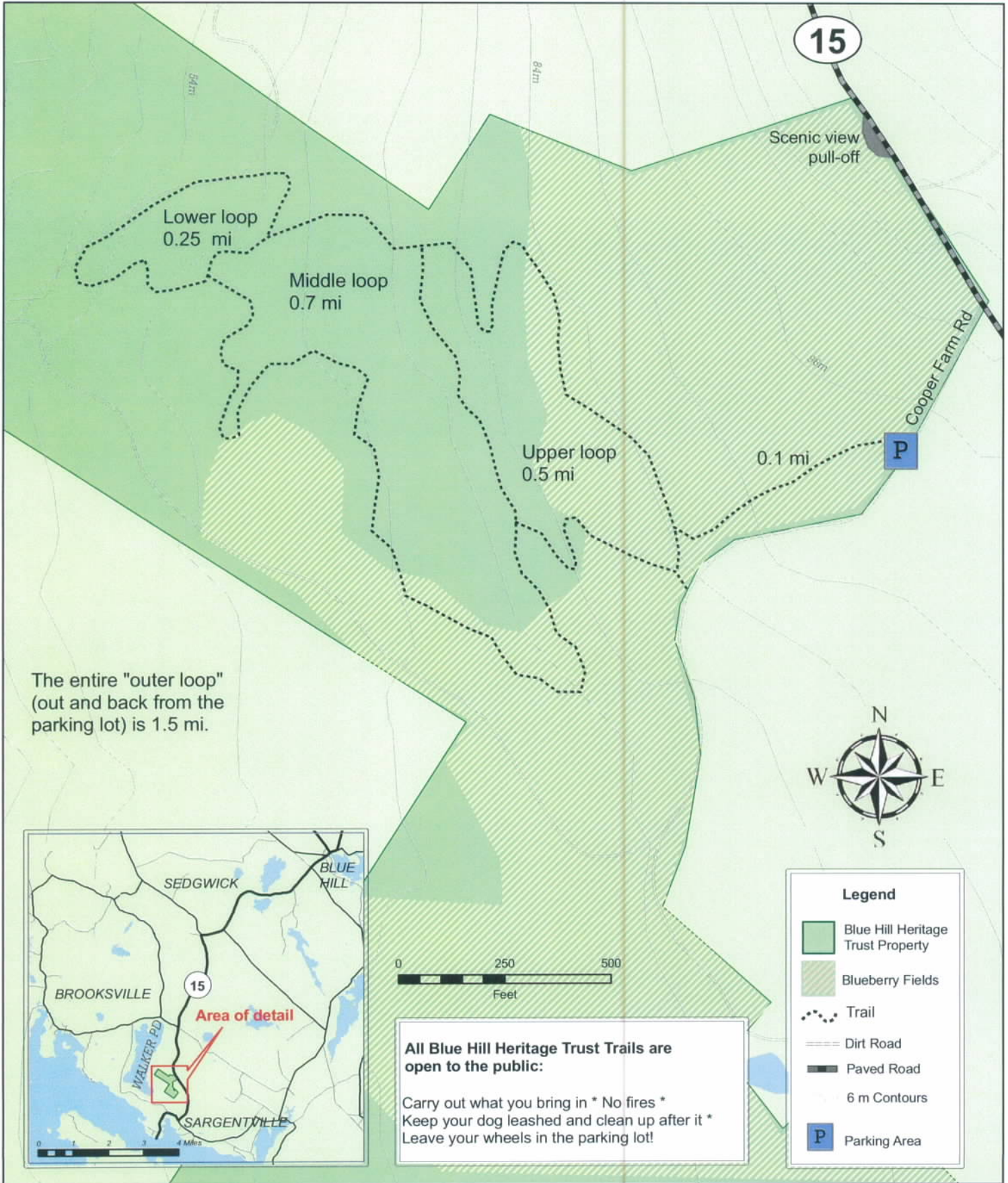

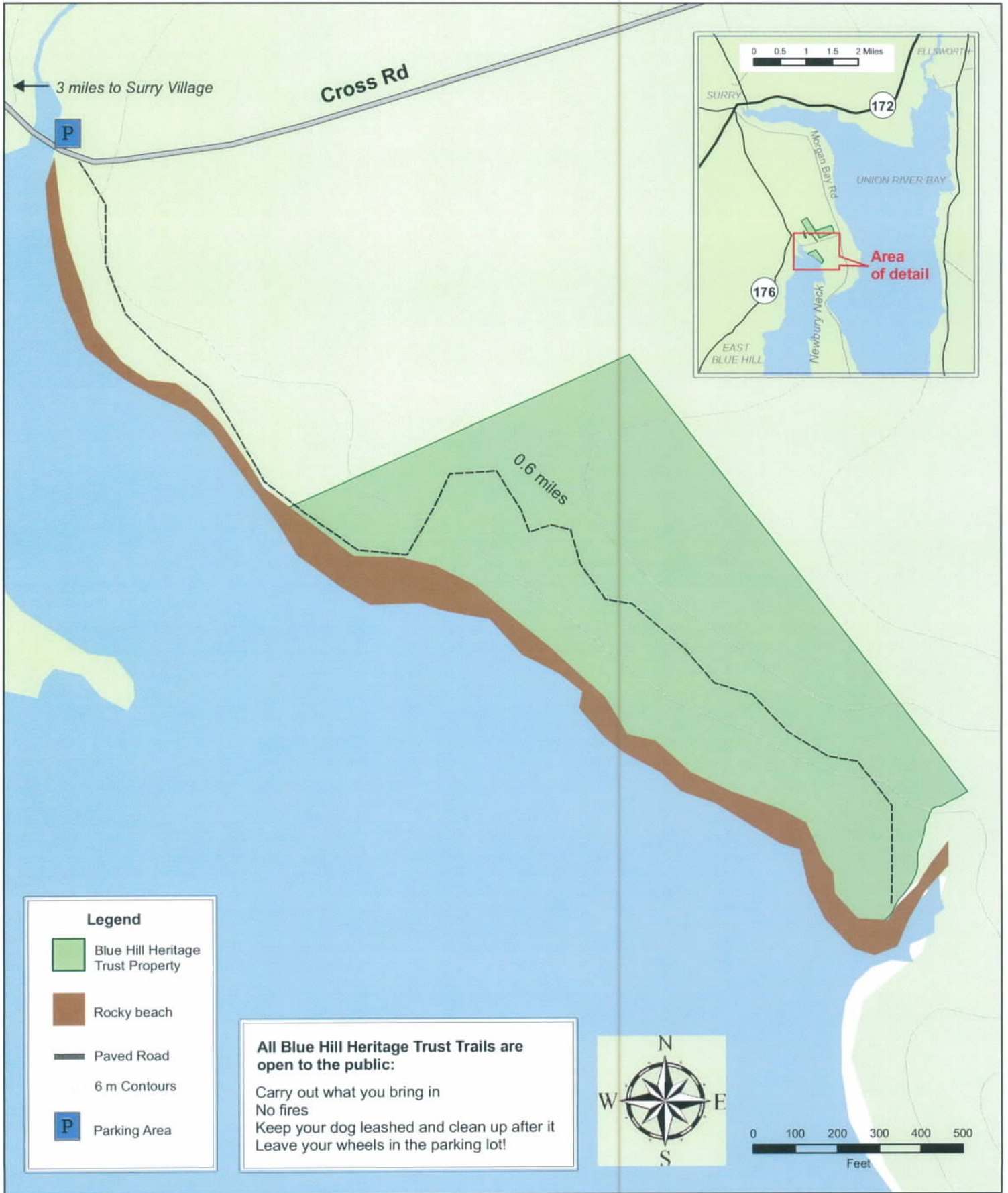


Caterpillar Hill Cooper Farm Trails, Sedgwick

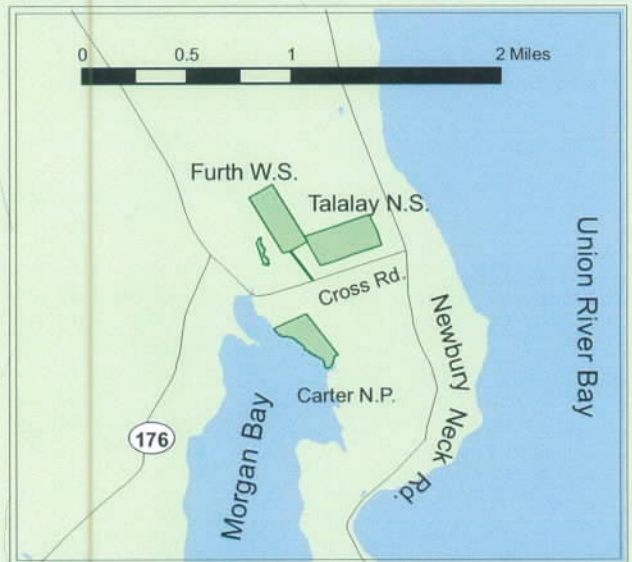

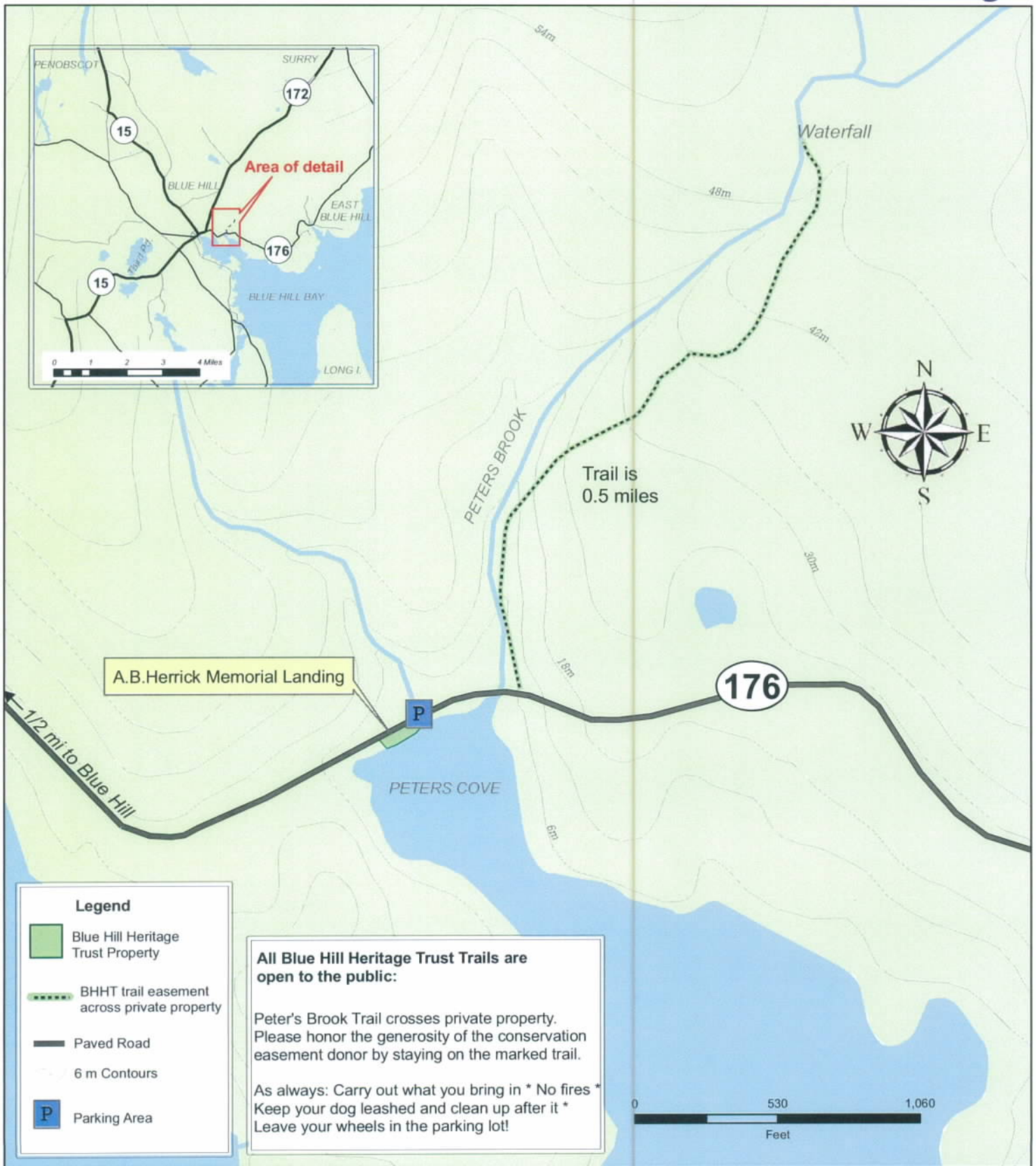

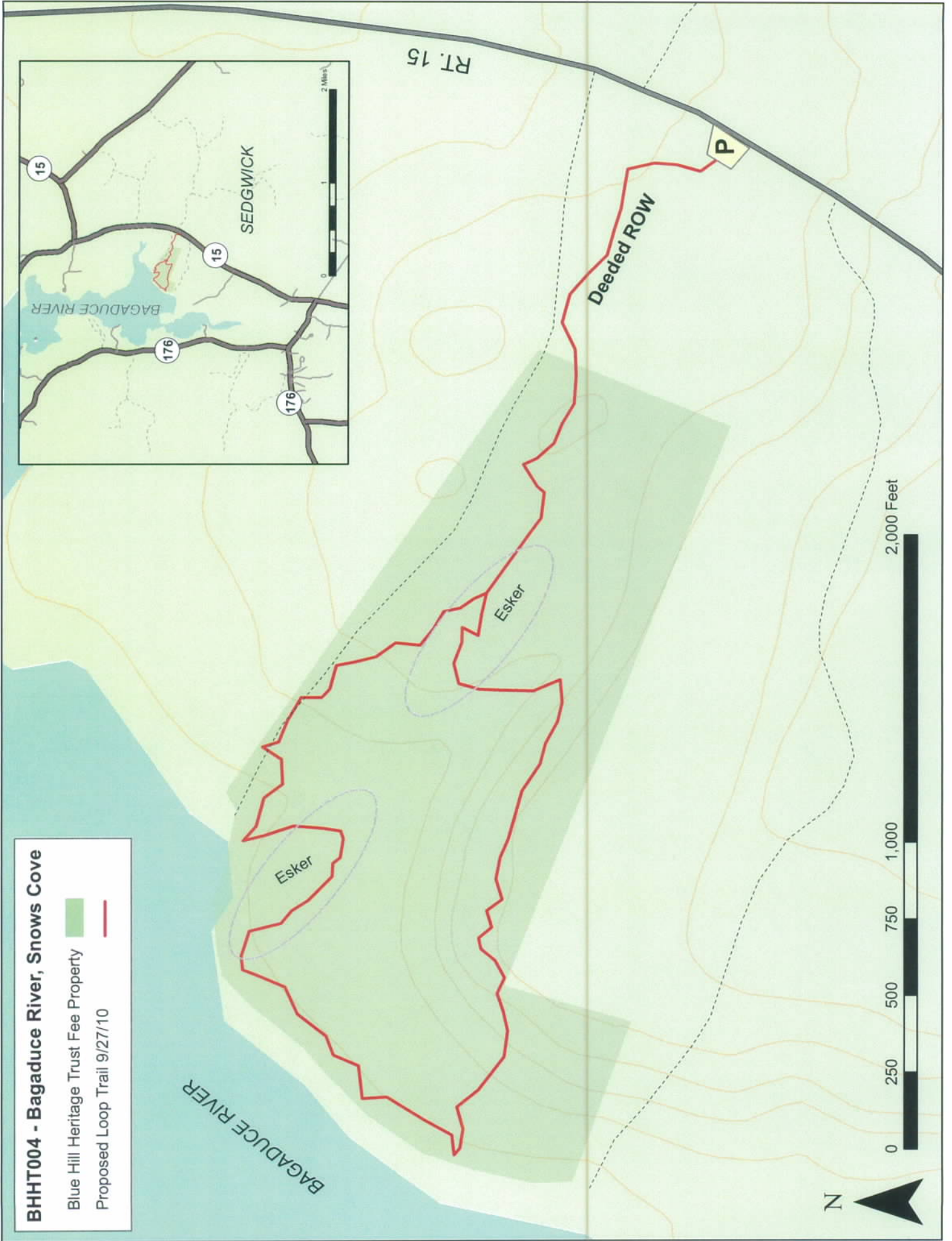
Peters Brook Trail and A.B.Herrick Memorial Landing



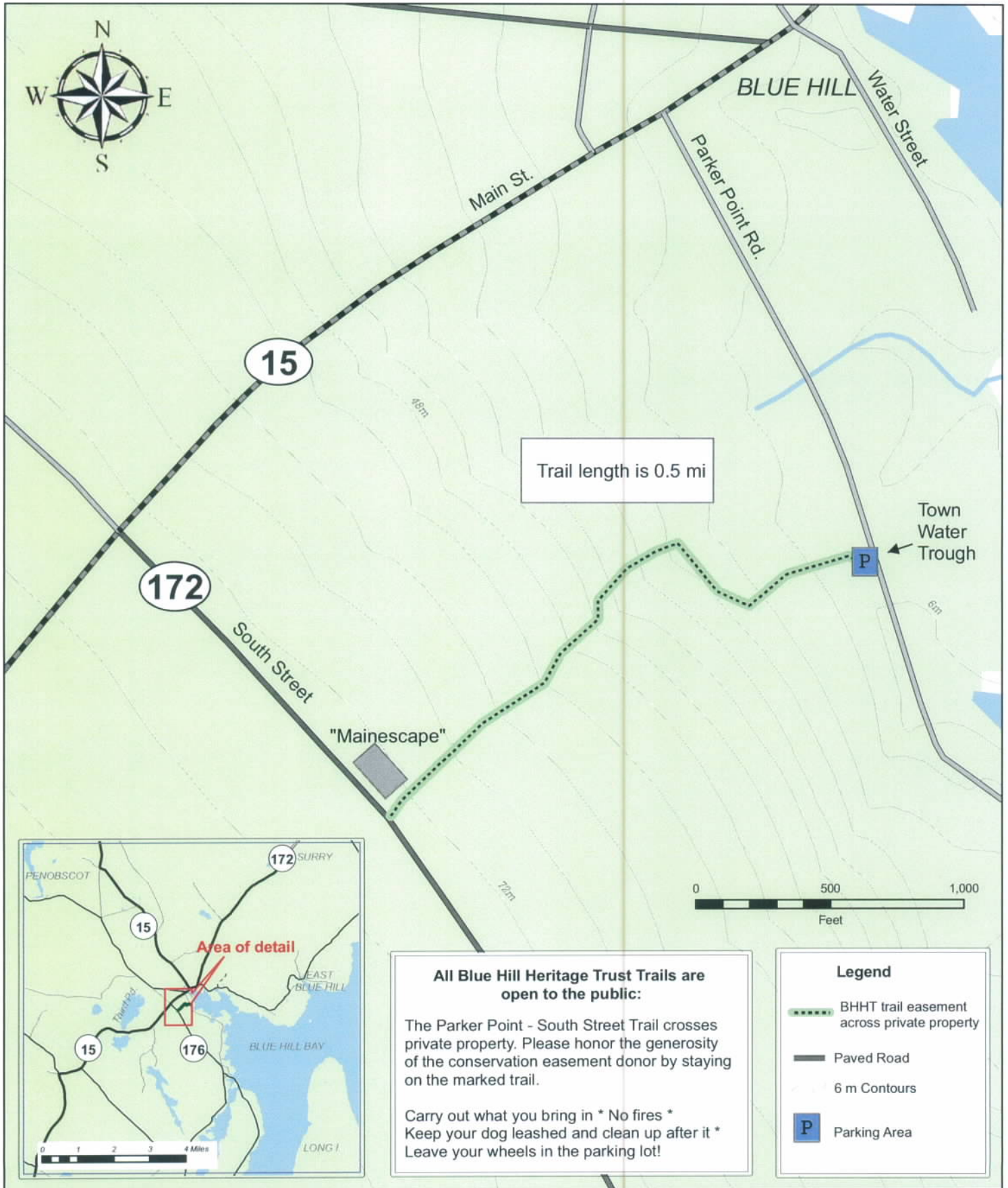
BHHT004 - Bagaduce River, Snows Cove

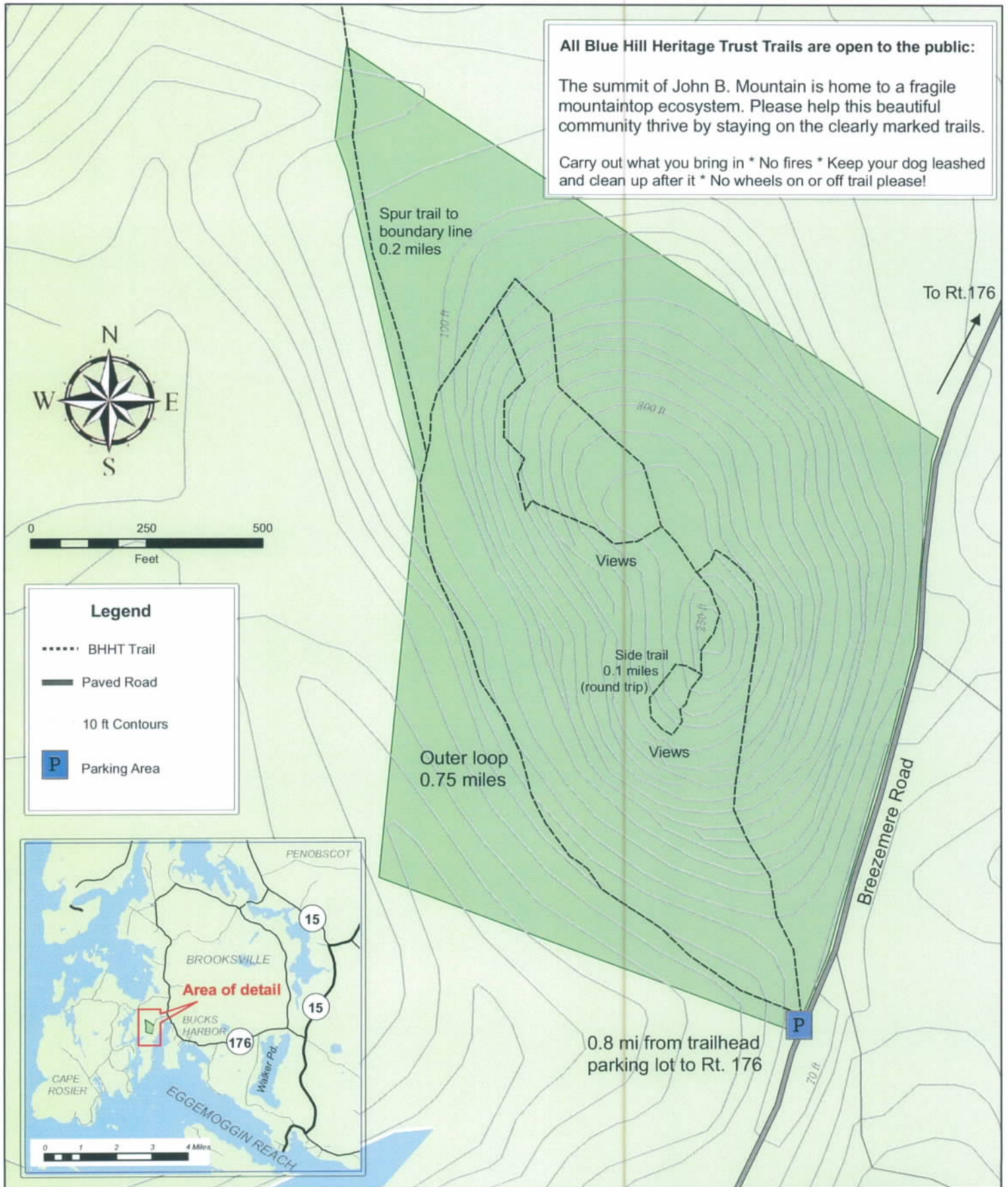
The Parker Point - South Street Trail crosses private property. Please honor the generosity of the conservation easement donor by staying on the marked trail.

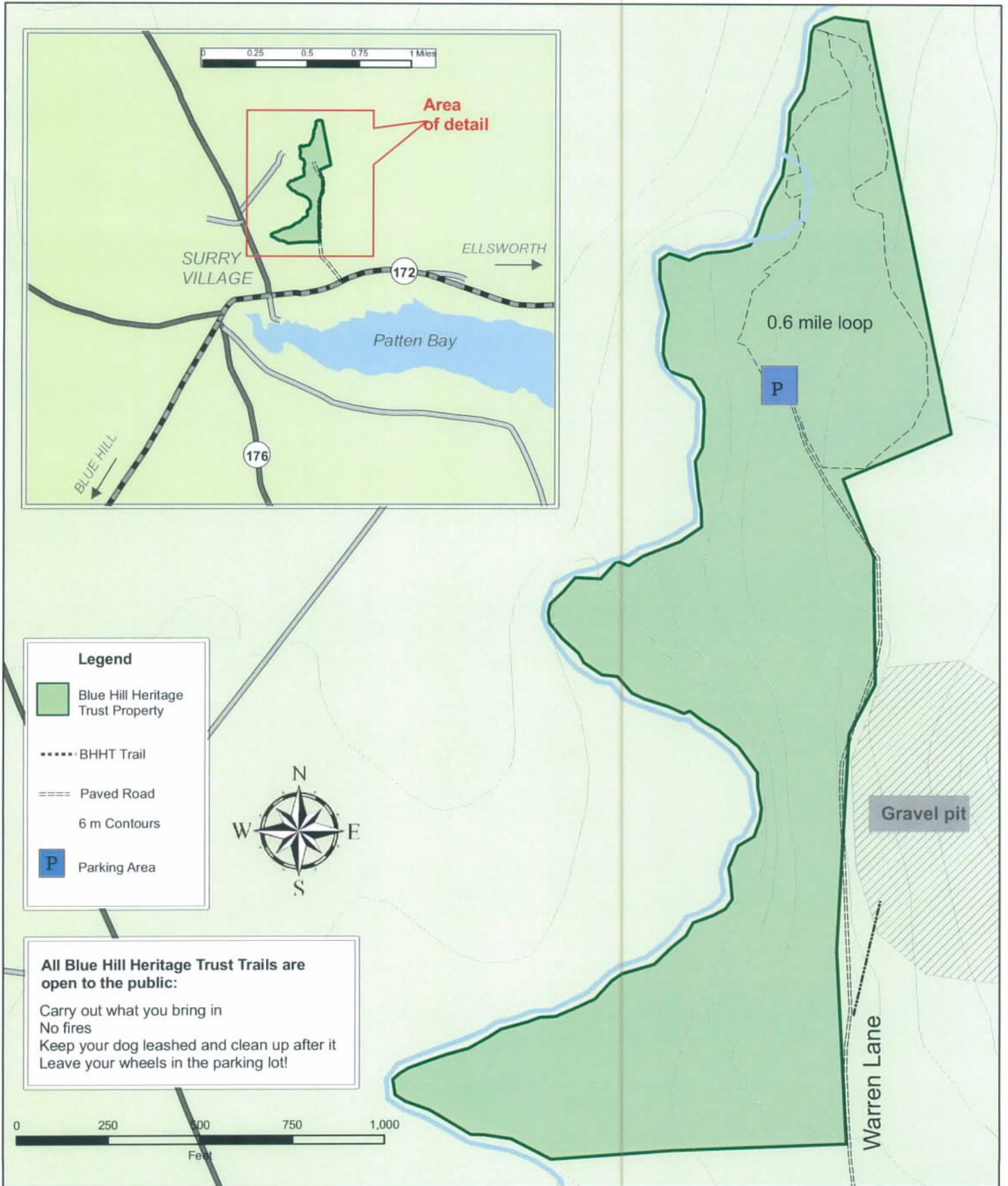
