

## TRAILHEAD LOCATIONS FOR THE BLUE HILL HERITAGE TRUST (2016)

1. **Patten Stream:** (Surry) From Blue Hill, take Route 172 toward Ellsworth. After passing through Surry Village, turn left onto Warren Lane. The trail begins on the west side of Warren Lane, 0.2 miles from Route 172.
2. **Furth Wildlife/ Talalay Nature Sanctuary:** (Surry) From Blue Hill, take Route 176 toward East Blue Hill 7.5 miles. Turn right onto Cross Road, trailhead is located 0.5 miles from Route 176 (parking lot on right, trail begins on left).
3. **Carter Nature Preserve:** (Surry) From Blue Hill, take Route 176 toward East Blue Hill 7.5 miles. Turn right onto Cross Road, trail begins on the right hand side of the road, 0.25 miles from Route 176.
4. **Blue Hill Mountain, Becton Trail:** (Blue Hill) From Blue Hill village, take Route 172 north toward Surry. Turn left onto Turkey Farm Road. The trailhead is located 0.6 miles on left.
5. **Blue Hill Mountain, Hayes Trail:** (Blue Hill) From Blue Hill village, take Route 15 north. After one mile, turn right onto Mountain Road. Continue on Mountain Road three quarters of a mile to the Hayes trailhead (parking lot on right, trail begins on left).
6. **Blue Hill Mountain, Osgood Trail:** (Blue Hill) From Blue Hill village, take Route 15 north. After one mile, turn right onto Mountain Road. Continue on Mountain Road for 0.5 mile to the Osgood trailhead (parking on right, trail begins on left).
7. **Post Office Trail:** (Blue Hill) Heads south from Mountain Road across from the Osgood Trailhead and leads to the Post Office in Blue Hill village. Hikers may start at the trailhead from the Post Office but please do not use this parking lot during business hours.
8. **Peters Brook Trail:** (Blue Hill) From Blue Hill, take Route 176 toward East Blue Hill. AB Herrick Landing is 0.5 miles on the right. The Peters Brook trail begins 100 feet further on the left hand side of the road.
9. **South Street Trail:** (Blue Hill) From Main St. in Blue Hill turn onto Parker Point Road by the Library. Follow 0.3 miles to parking area at the old town fountain. The trail connects to South Street. Hikers may start from the trailhead at Mainescape from the South Street side, but please do not use this parking lot during business hours.
10. **Salt Pond Access:** (Sedgwick) Follow Route 172 South from the intersection of Routes 15 and 172 (near TradeWinds store parking lot). After 6 miles, turn left onto Hales Hill Road. The access point is on the left, 0.1 miles from the intersection with Route 172.
11. **Hundred Acre Wood:** (Brooklin) From the intersection of Route 175 and Hales Wood Road in Brooklin, travel 0.75 miles south on Hales Wood Road to the “four corners” intersection. Take a left on High Street. Access to the property is located 500 feet on the left side of High Street. Limited parking is available along the road shoulder.
12. **Cooper Farm:** (Sedgwick) From Blue Hill, take Route 15 (the Mines Road) toward Brooksville and Sedgwick. At the intersection with Route 176 (Gray’s Corner), turn left to follow Route 15. Continue 4.3 miles until the Caterpillar Hill Scenic Turnout on right. Immediately after the Scenic Turnout, turn right onto Cooper Farm Road. Parking area is on right.
13. **Snows Cove Preserve:** (Sedgwick) From the intersection of the Mines Road (Rt. 15) and Rt. 176 in Sedgwick, travel 1.2 miles south. Trailhead is on the right side of the road.
14. **Kingdom Woods (South Trail):** (Blue Hill) The Mines Road trailhead is located on the north side of the Mines Road across from the 40/15 tennis facility, 2.2 miles from the intersection of South Street and the Mines Road/ Rt. 15 in Blue Hill.

## TRAILHEAD LOCATIONS FOR THE BLUE HILL HERITAGE TRUST (2016)

15. **Kingdom Woods (North Trail)**: (Blue Hill) Take Route 177 from Blue Hill Town Hall heading toward Penobscot. After 1.5 miles, turn left onto Kingdom Road. The main trail head is located on the south side of the Kingdom Road, 1.5 miles from Route 177.
16. **Kingdom Woods (Nature Trail)**: From the North Trail parking area, go 0.2 miles further west on the Kingdom Road, 1.7 miles from Rt. 177. Parking area is on the south side of the road.
17. **Bagaduce River Access**: (Brooksville) The trailhead is located on the Bagaduce Road (Route 175), 1.6 miles from the intersection with Route 176 or 2.4 miles from the intersection with the Coastal Road (Route 176) in North Brooksville.
18. **Snow Natural Area**: (Brooksville) Cross the Bagaduce Reversing Falls Bridge on Route 175/176. At the stop sign, take a right and go north only 0.25 miles onto Young's Point Road. Bear right at the fork. Look for a small parking area on the right marked by a Blue Hill Heritage Trust sign. Please do not park on the road.
19. **Weinland Nature Study Area**: (Penobscot) Located off of Route 175, 1 mile south of Route 175/177 intersection. Turn left onto Gray Ridge Road (unmarked). Parking area is located 0.25 miles on right.
20. **Sherm Perkins Park**: (Penobscot) Located in Penobscot Village on Route 175/199 immediately west of the former Bay View Market and Take Out. Limited parking is available along the road shoulder.
21. **Greenbie Natural Area**: (Castine) Take Route 175/176 south from Orland, and continue on 166 after 175 turns left in Penobscot. At the junction of 166 and 166A, turn right onto 166 (the Shore Rd) and go 2 miles. The parking area is on the left, just after a large green transformer box.
22. **Ferry Landing Natural Area**: (Brooksville) Cross the Bagaduce Reversing Falls Bridge on Route 175/176. At the stop sign, take a right, following Route 176 north. Follow this for approximately 3 miles, until you come to the intersection that is the center of West Brooksville. Take a sharp right onto Ferry Road. After 1 mile the road splits. Take the right fork, the Jones Point Road. The Ferry Landing Natural Area parking area is on the left with a Blue Hill Heritage Trust sign. Parking area is limited to 2 vehicles.
23. **Hatch Cove Preserve**: (Castine) Take Route 166A south towards Castine turning right onto Wadsworth Cove Road before crossing the Neck. Park along edge of Wadsworth Cove Road. No formalized trail, open fields on both sides of Route 166.
24. **Schumacher Preserve**: (Castine) Take Route 166A south towards Castine. Just past Wadsworth Cove Road there is a sign and parking area on the left.
25. **John B. Mountain**: (Brooksville) The trailhead and parking area are located on the west side of Breezemere Road, 0.8 miles from its intersection with Route 176.
26. **Bluff Head**: (Sedgwick) From the intersection of the Mines Road (Rt. 15) and Rt. 176 in Sedgwick, proceed straight onto Rope Ferry Road for approximately 1/8 mile. Parking area and trailhead is on the right side of road.
