



BeeAware! Bee House Materials List



One 1" x 6" x 8' board (cedar or pine) board will make 3 complete bee houses.

Materials required for each bee house

- 1" x 6" x 32" board (cedar or pine). *Avoid pressure treated wood.*
- 4" x 4" x 5.5" of wood post – OR – 5' metal U post.
- Waterproof wood glue
- 2" 6d stainless steel siding nails w/annular ring shank (20 needed)
- 1/4" x 2 1/2" hex head lag screws, stainless steel (2 needed for mounting the finished bee house)
- 1/4" x 5/8" OD flat washers, stainless steel (2 needed for mounting the finished bee house)
