Acorn Dolls!

Materials:

- Felt
- Pipecleaners
- Yarn
- Wool
- Acorn cap
- Wooden bead
- Glue gun and glue sticks/or elmers glue

Instructions:

- Cut a pipe cleaner to about 6 inches and bend in half for the legs and torso.
- 2. Cut another piece about 3-4 inches long and wrap around the torso twice to make arms.
- 3. For the hands and feet bend in the sharp ends a little bit.
- 4. Using yarn, start wrapping it above the feet all the way up one leg and down another. Then wrap the arms the same way, leaving a neck at the top free of yarn. You can tie the yarn off or use a bit of glue to hold it in place.
- Next, make a tunic out of felt: cut a long rectangle, fold in half, and use scissors to make a small hole in the folded side. This is the neck hole!
- 6. Slip the tunic over the body and tie with some yarn, embroidery floss or string at the waist line. Decorate the tunic if desired. You can cut shapes out of felt and sew or glue on or add a bell to the waist.
- 7. Glue on the wooden bead head.
- 8. Glue on some wool for hair.
- 9. Glue on the acorn cap.
