3 ACCESS TRAIL: 0.25 Miles. Easy. This trail takes you from Cross Rd to the intersection of the Furth & Talalay Trails.

4 FURTH TRAIL: 0.8 Miles. Easy to moderate. This takes hikers on a loop through migrating songbird habitat, active beaver habitat, young forest, and a lovely brook.

5 TALALAY TRAIL: 1 Mile. Easy to moderate. This loop winds through mossy old-growth forest and a white cedar swamp. The tall trees also house nesting migratory songbirds, so be sure to bring your binoculars.
