

### About John B Mountain

John B. Mountain was acquired, in 2009, thanks to the generosity of the Davis family. The land and trails are maintained and protected with member support, and includes 38 acres.

Keep an eye out for the old cemetery and the stunning views over Penobscot Bay at the top. Horseshoe Cove, and its tidal flats, will be on your right, and Orcutt Cove on your left. On a clear day, the Camden Hills are visible.

At 250 ft, John B. is technically a hill, along Eggemoggin Reach and Horseshoe Cove. A short loop trail to the summit is steep and rocky in sections. A short spur trail off "Old School House Road" runs 0.2 miles to Horseshoe Cove.
