

## About Peters Brook & A.B. Herrick Memorial Landing


200 acres around Peters Brook were conserved, from 2005 and 2015, thanks to land gifts and easements from the Cowan, Mitchell, Pert, Herrick, and Byers Families.





The brook drains the uplands east of the village into Peters Cove, a part of Blue Hill Bay. Look for the waterfall and bathing pool.

A.B. Herrick Memorial Landing gives public water access to Blue Hill Bay. Launch a kayak or swim at this scenic spot.

**1** Peters Brook Trail: 0.5 Mile. Easy. Leads directly to the falls.

**2** Three Bridges Trail: 0.5 Miles. Easy to Moderate. Crosses the brook and leads to an observation deck overlooking the waterfall.
