

South Street - Parker Point Trail 0.5 Miles, Moderate. Connects Parker Point Rd with South Street, near Mainescape Garden Shop, and can be used as a scenic shortcut between the South St. shopping area and the village center. The trail cuts through a mixed forest on a gentle slope, and crosses several intermittent streams.

This 11.5-acre woodland corridor was protected, in 2005, thanks to the generous gift of an easement, and member support. Though this trail is open to the public, it runs on private land, so please be respectful guests. Keep an eye out for granite formations, beautiful forest, ephemeral plants, and seasonal streams. In 2019 and 2020, the trail was the focus of a major upgrade to mitigate erosion and trail wear. This was funded by the Quimby Foundation and the Maine Bureau of Parks and Lands.
