

About Wallamatogus

Thanks to the generous support of donors, along with state and federal grants, the Penobscot Community Forest at Wallamatogus Mountain (336 acres) was acquired in 2023. Blue Hill Heritage Trust was assisted in this acquisition by The Conservation Fund and Maine Coast Heritage Trust.

The property is dominated by 170 acres of former blueberry fields that were commercially harvested until 2016. BHHT keeps these fields open because they provide important open-field habitat for birds and animals. The fields also continue to have good blueberry growth. In season, this is good food for animals and humans alike.

From the top of the hill, there is a spectacular view of the Bagaduce River watershed. Penobscot Bay can be seen to the west, and to the east Acadia National Park is visible behind Blue Hill Mountain.

This property is part of an important conservation focus and is part of a larger effort to conserve land around Wallamatogus Mountain.
